No jewellery.	Jewellery and make-up must be unobtrusive. Students are allowed to wear one pair of earrings only.

2. **All male students must be clean shaven.** Male students are not permitted to wear beards and/or moustaches unless the Head has granted **in writing** a dispensation on religious grounds.
