

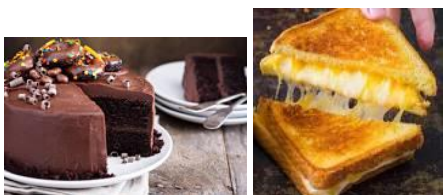
# Florance Nightingale

Write a paragraph about why that person is significant to you?

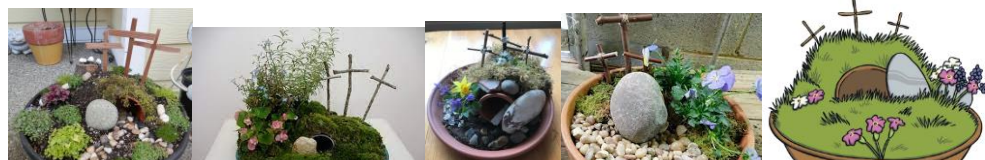
- Have they inspired you?
